WHAT COMMUNITY NEED WOULD OUR DONATION HELP MEET? *

Veteran engagement, connection, and networking.

22 2 None believes that connections save lives. People served include active duty, retired, and reserve members of all branches of the military. In July 2020, 22 2 None purchased the former South Boardman Elementary School and are now bringing it back to life as Belay My Last Barracks.

Through consistent, community-based programming, 22 2 None creates multiple entry points for veterans to engage and build meaningful relationships. Weekly Moral, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) Monday night dinners serve as the cornerstone of this effort, providing a reliable and welcoming space for connection. Additional programming includes family-centered events, peer-driven activities, and dedicated gatherings for women veterans and spouses, ensuring inclusive and accessible support.

The organization also offers deeper engagement through outdoor and experiential programming such as hunting, fishing, and seasonal activities that promote trust, connection, and mental well-being. Community-wide initiatives, including awareness events and outreach efforts, further strengthen public support and engagement with the veteran population.

In addition, 22 2 None facilitates access to resilience-based training opportunities that equip veterans and their families with practical tools to manage stress, process trauma, and build stronger relationships. These programs reinforce the organization's long-term commitment to suicide prevention and overall well-being.

22 2 None also provides a network connection to other veteran service organizations that offer services that we do not, we volunteer to assist with labor projects such as land clearing, property clean-up, moving, etc

The gift will be utilized to help fund the \$310,000 kitchen renovation to change it from a "keep warm and serve" kitchen to a full-service commercial kitchen.

The number of Antrim County vets & family members directly connected: 150. Over the counties-wide region and through events, thousands of veterans and families are reached each year.

Since May 2026, Kitchen Project Funds raised to date: \$14,763

The funds from our 100 Women Who Care group would be earmarked for a kitchen range hood, fire suppression equipment, and an air handling unit.

MY RELATIONSHIP/EXPERIENCE WITH THIS ORGANIZATION *

After learning about 22 to None, I presented the group to 100 WWC in May and have introduced additional potential grant opportunities to them.
