Acme Christian Thrift Store & Food Pantry (ACTS) was selected by our members to receive our May collective donation of \$22,800.

Our gift will be used to help meet a growing need for food and supplies resulting from the end of COVID supplemental support. A portion of the gift will also be used toward the purchase of a generator to protect ACTS' food inventory.

ACTS' Carolyn Synol said *"This gift from 100 Women Who Care will provide sustenance for our organization as well as for our clients."*

ACTS provides food for 70 families per month and depends on the help of 110 volunteers. In addition to food, ACTS provides medical supplies, diapers and feminine hygiene products. ACTS also serves as a familiar "community center" for its clients.
